Meet Capt. Robin McKenzie Davis-Jackson Alumni Award Honoree

Capt. Robin McKenzie served as the commanding officer of the Naval School of Health Sciences-San Diego and interim commanding officer of the Medical Enlisted Training Center Command, Fort Sam Houston, Texas. A graduate of Bridgeport High School, she received her bachelor's degree in nursing from West Virginia Wesleyan College in Buckhannon in 1977. She was commissioned as an ensign in the United States Navy Nurse Corps in March 1978.

Capt. McKenzie's assignments included the National Naval Medical Center, Bethesda, Md.; Charleston Naval Hospital, Charleston, S.C.; Naval Medical Center, Portsmouth, Va.; Naval Hospital Roosevelt Roads, Puerto Rico; Naval Hospital Jacksonville, Florida; and Naval Medical Center, San Diego, Calif. Between her tour in "Rosie Roads," as it is fondly remembered, and assignment to Jacksonville, Fla., Capt. McKenzie was selected for Duty Under Instruction (DUINS) at the University of Florida in Gainesville. She received a master's degree as a clinical nurse specialist in critical care nursing. She was selected for DUINS a second time in 1997 and received her doctorate in nursing from the University of San Diego in San Diego, Calif. Before transferring to San Diego as the executive officer, she served at Naval Medical Center, Portsmouth, Va., as the senior nurse executive and researcher.

Capt. McKenzie served as the specialty leader to the surgeon general of the Navy for Critical Care Nursing 1990-1996. She is a member of Sigma Theta Tau National Honor Society for Nursing and several military and national nursing organizations.

Her military awards included the Legion of Merit, Navy Meritorious Service Medal (2), Navy Commendation Medal (2), Navy Unit Commendation, National Defense Service Medal(2), Global War on Terrorism Medal and Overseas Service Ribbon. Among her civilian awards, she is the recipient of the Hewlett Packard Award in Nursing Excellence and Florida Nurse's Association Clinical Excellence Award.
